



Lindfield Arts Festival Bursary Terms and Conditions

- Expression of Interest to be completed by 1st May 2019
- Online applications only are accepted <https://www.surveymonkey.co.uk/r/8Y5MDYH>
- On receipt of the Expression of Interest, applicants will be sent a Full Application form by email.
- Closing date for Full Applications 31st May 2019
- The Bursary is open to anyone who lives in the Parish of Lindfield, Rural Parish of Lindfield and the immediate Mid Sussex area
- The definition of the Bursary from Lindfield Arts Festival is that it will be awarded to a local resident who can demonstrate their passion and desire to start or continue an arts discipline, whether it is visual, performing, arts or craft.
- The applicant can be of any age, from seven years old on 15th September 2019.
- The application must demonstrate how the funds will be used, the time frame and the anticipated results.
- The successful applicant will need to provide evidence and receipts of how the funds are spent; whether it is on materials, a course, training etc.
- The Bursary funds need to be dispensed by August 2020
- If appropriate, the successful applicant will be willing to perform/exhibit at #LAF 2020.
- Lindfield Arts Festival Trustees, Committee Members and others closely connected with the charity are excluded from applying for the Bursary.
- The judges' decision will be final.
- One application per person is allowed.
- The successful applicant must be willing to take part in reasonable press and PR activities.
- No correspondence or discussions can be entered into with Lindfield Arts Festival Trustees, Committee or the Judges to influence the decision-making process.
